Due by 12/2. Minimum of 6 points. Can attempt up to 14 points.

<p>Legend - Create a legend for your tribe that reflects their traditions. It can explain why they eat what they eat, or why they wear what they wear or just about their way of life. (4 points)</p>	<p>Day in the Life - Journal entry, day in the life of a Native Californian. Choose either an adult or a child and create a journal / diary entry showing their life. Include details about their homes, their trade, their ceremonies, etc. You may add pictures. (6 points)</p>	<p>Recipe – recipe from what they eat. Draw an appropriate picture. Write a paragraph as to why one should make it and when one would eat it, whether it is for a ceremony your tribe has, or in everyday life. (4 points)</p>
<p>Houses / Map – draw what your tribe’s house looked like and explain in a paragraph how it was used. (4 points) Make a map of how a Native Californian village might look like. (4 points)</p>	<h2 style="font-size: 2em;">Student Choice</h2>	<p>Brochure – Get people to come and trade with your tribe. You may also create a brochure to try to get people to join your tribe. Explain either the ways of life, or items that you have to trade and what they’re good for. (6 points)</p>
<p>Native Californian Song – Write and perform a song. You should pick a familiar tune, like “Twinkle Twinkle Little Star” and rewrite the words to make the song relevant to the period. I.e. “Chumash Chumash building weirs” (2 points)</p>	<p>Advertisement – Design an ad for an item of clothing that your tribe members wear. This should include why you should get one. (4 points) Design an ad for a ceremony that your tribe members would hold. Be sure to include why the ceremony is held. (4 points)</p>	<p>Newspaper Articles – You’re the reporter! Report on a ceremony held by your tribe. Paragraph with a picture! (4 points) You may also report on their trade. Include details to show your understanding of why each tribe would trade with each other. (4 points)</p>
